Please label all items (where indicated) and purchase suggested brands, if possible

- All students will receive a Midland Elementary take-home folder to be used throughout the year.
- **Gym shoes are required for daily PE classes and for playing on playground equipment outside.** Students who do not wear gym/tennis shoes to school must bring a pair of gym/tennis shoes to change into for PE class and recess. Parents may want to consider purchasing an inexpensive pair of gym/tennis shoes for students to keep in lockers here at school.
- **Book bags with wheels on them DO NOT FIT IN OUR SCHOOL LOCKERS.** Please try to purchase backpacks/book bags that **DO NOT HAVE WHEELS ON THEM.** Thank you!

Kindergarten:

- Paint shirt
- One large box of facial tissues
- Rest mat or towel (*labeled with name*)
- One pink eraser (*labeled with name*)
- Two containers of Wet Ones
- One large container of Clorox Disinfecting Wipes
- One set of Crayola watercolor paints
- All boys should purchase one box of gallon sized zipper sealable bags (i.e.: Ziploc)
- All girls should purchase one box of sandwich sized zipper sealable bags (i.e.: Ziploc)
- Four primary (fat) pencils (*label each individual pencil with name*)
- One box of 24 Crayola crayons
- Two 4 oz. bottles of Elmer's glue
- One set of Crayola Classic Colors washable markers (8 markers)
- One pair of child's Fiskars scissors (*labeled with name*)
- One 5x8 plastic school supply box (*labeled with name on outside*)

First Grade: Please label all items with student's name

- Paint shirt
- One large box of facial tissues
- Pencils and pink erasers as needed
- One container of wet wipes
- One watercolor paint set
- One plastic 2-pocket folder
- All boys should purchase on package of 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 5 index cards
- All girls should purchase on box of any size zipper sealable bags (i.e.: Ziploc)
- One box of 24 Crayola crayons (non-washable)
- One 8 oz. bottle of Elmer's glue
- One set of washable markers
- One pair of child's Fiskars scissors
- One 5x8 plastic school supply box
- One set of colored pencils
- One spiral single subject theme notebook (not perforated)

Second Grade: These items SHOULD NOT be labeled; students will share these at their tables throughout the year:

- Two boxes of 24 crayons
- 48 pencils (yellow #2, no decorative pencils, please)

- 24 Pencil-top erasers
- Two bottles of white glue
- One set of washable markers
- One watercolor paint set
- Four glue sticks
- Two large boxes of facial tissues
- One pair of scissors with a point
- Paint shirt
- One 5x8 plastic school supply box
- All boys should purchase one large container of wipes (for hands/face; not Clorox or Lysol)
- All girls should purchased one box of quart sized zipper sealable bags (i.e.: Ziploc)
- Two one-subject spiral notebooks
- One composition notebook

Third Grade:

- One box of crayons
- One small bottle of white Elmer's glue
- One pair of Fiskars scissors
- #2 Pencils
- One set of colored pencils
- One large box of facial tissues
- 200 sheets of wide-ruled loose leaf notebook paper
- One pink eraser
- One set of washable markers
- One watercolor paint set
- One two-pocket folder
- One spiral notebook
- One 5x8 plastic school supply box
- One 1 inch three-ring binder (Not Trapper Keeper)
- One container of Clorox Disinfecting wipes

Fourth Grade:

- #2 pencils (no mechanical pencils, please!)
- One box of crayons
- One set of washable markers
- One glue stick
- One pair of scissors
- One highlighter
- One one-subject notebook
- One ruler (inch/cm that measures to the 1/8 inch)
- Two packs of loose-leaf notebook papers (no spiral notebooks, please!)
- Seven plain 2-pocket folders
- One 5x8 plastic school supply box
- Two large boxes of facial tissues
- All girls should purchase one pack of dry erase markers (black only)
- All boys should purchase one package of 3 ½ x 5 index cards
- All girls should purchase one package of 3x3 Post It notes
- All boys should purchase one container of Clorox Disinfecting Wipes
